POLICE ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIPS

Scholarships are available to dependent children of ordinary members or deceased ordinary members of the Police Association to assist them to complete their tertiary education.

Applications are invited from eligible pupils who are sitting for the higher school certificate examination this year.

The Association scholarships are awarded according to the following conditions:

1. Names of Scholarships.

The Scholarships shall be known as the "Police Association of New South Wales Scholarship."

2. The object of the Scholarships shall be to provide an annual award to assist dependent children of financial ordinary members, or dependent children of a person who, at the time of death, was a financial ordinary member, to complete the course of tertiary education.

3. Value.

The Scholarships will carry an allowance of \$500.

4. Conditions of Award

- (a) Scholarships shall be awarded annually.
- (b) Eligible applicants shall be pupils who are dependent children of financial ordinary members or dependent children of a person who, at the time of death, was a financial ordinary member.
- (c) As from 2017, the Scholarship shall be tenable for the duration of one full time undergraduate course at University, College of Advanced Education or similar tertiary institution.
- (d)i The Scholarships shall be awarded on the results of the Higher School Certificate Examination and a rank of 75 or more under the Australian Tertiary Admission Rank (ATAR) or a rank of 26 or more under the International Baccalaureate (IB).
- (d)ii If an applicant does not meet the threshold, additional information is to be supplied by the applicant for the Executive to adjudicate outside the terms of the ATAR 75 benchmark.
- (e) The financial position of parents of applicants shall not be taken into consideration in determining the award.
- (f) The parents or guardians of the recipient of the Scholarships shall undertake that the student will remain at the Institution for the duration of the Scholarships.
- (g) The Scholarships shall be held subject to satisfactory progress and conduct, as indicated by reports furnished by the institute at which the Scholarship holder is enrolled. It may be withdrawn, suspended, or varied at the discretion of the Executive.
- (h) The allowance shall be paid each year at the discretion of the Executive.
- (i) The Scholarships may be held concurrently with a State Bursary or any other award, provided that such is consistent with the conditions of the other bursary or award.

5. Administration

- (a) The Scholarship shall be administered by the Executive.
- (b) Applicants shall supply copies of their Higher School Certificate and the aggregate marks awarded by the University and Colleges Admission Centre.
- (c) The value of Scholarships awarded shall not exceed the income derived from the interest earned by the Reserve Funds of the Association each year.
- (d) The number of Scholarships shall be determined by the Executive.
